

## Preparing for Pentecost

Christmas has Advent, Easter has Lent, but the Festival of Pentecost doesn't have really have a time leading up to it. However, in the last few years the Methodist Church has been a partner in [Thy Kingdom Come](#).

**Thy Kingdom Come** is a global prayer movement in which Christians pray that people would come to know Jesus. It takes place between Ascension Day and Pentecost, so this year it falls between 30 May – 9 June 2019.

During **Thy Kingdom Come**, people commit to pray with God's worldwide family –individually, as a family or as a church.

The invitation is simply for people to pray in whatever way they want, with whoever they want and wherever they can, that others might know something of Jesus Christ.

If you receive the free Methodist magazine [the connexion](#) you will have got a copy of the Methodist Church's booklet for **Thy Kingdom Come**, *I hear you differently*. This has a 5-10 minute prayer reflection for days between Ascension and Pentecost.

Each morning starting on Friday 31 May, the circuit can send to your inbox that day's reflection so you can join in, praying 'thy kingdom come'.
